


The Best Faculty of Agriculture in Medan



Medan Area University is a private tertiary institution in Medan, North Sumatra Province. Indonesia, which was founded by Haji Agus Salim Siregar in 1983. The Chancellor since February 2018 is Prof. Dr. Dadan Ramdan, M.Eng., M.Sc. At present the University of Medan Area has seven Faculties with 16 study programs for Strata 1 (S1) and 4 study programs for Strata 2 (S2). The seven faculties, namely the Faculty of Engineering, the Faculty of Agriculture, the Faculty of Economics, the Faculty of Law, the Faculty of Social and Political Sciences, the Faculty of Psychology and the Faculty of Biology already have ACCREDITED status for all study programs that they hold with an average grade of "B".

The Faculty of Agriculture, University of Medan Area, is the Best Faculty of Agriculture in Medan, North Sumatra because one of the existing study programs is the Agribusiness Study Program, the only one that has received an "A" accreditation in North Sumatra . Faculty of Agriculture, University of Medan Area was established in 1983. People who reach 36 years (established since 1983) with a teaching staff profile of 5 professors, 12 people holding doctorates and the rest holding master degrees are supported by good academic facilities and infrastructure, which also makes the faculty agriculture field medan area one of the leading private tertiary institutions in Indonesia.
